

# More Kyrgyz gold for Manas

## **NEWLY listed Manas Resources has reported further high-grade gold results from the Isfairamsai project in the Kyrgyz Republic.**

Diamond drilling at the western end of the Shambesai prospect returned results of 35m at 4.85 grams per tonne gold from 57m, including 13m at 8.75gpt gold, 34m at 4.09gpt gold from 28m, including 7.6m at 11.8gpt gold, and 14.6m at 5.15gpt gold from 33m, including 5.8m at 9.88gpt gold.

Out of a total of 20 holes drilled along the western zone, 15 encountered gold mineralisation.

The prospect has been drilled intermittently over a 1km strike length and infill drilling, along with further extensional drilling to the west, is being completed.

Previous drilling at the prospect has intersected gold grading up to 23gpt.

The Shambesai prospect is 8km south of the Obdilla prospect, which has an indicated gold resource of 353,000oz and an inferred resource of 132,000oz.

Manas Resources debuted on the Australian Securities Exchange last week at a 5% premium to its 20c issue price, after raising \$6 million in its initial public offering.
